- All 1<sup>st</sup> place winners of each class will be automatically be entered into the Championship Awards Evening class in October, for example; if you are placed first in the Intro in any of the competition dates, you will be entered into the Intro class at the Championship Awards evening. Minimum of 4 classes to be entered and completed to qualify for the Championship.
- Points awarded for March, April, May, June, July, August & September competitions only, as follows:

  1<sup>st</sup> = 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1 point. No points are awarded for the Championship Awards Evening.
- 3 Entry fee will be £10 per class completion of 4 classes over 4 separate nights qualifies you for half price entry for your Championship class. Hire of a Long Lane Horse/Pony £10 per horse, per night.
- 4 Prizes will be awarded at the Championship Awards Evening to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed in each class for Dressage and to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and & 3<sup>rd</sup> placed in the Overall League Champion.
- Cancellations: 24 hours' notice must be given for a refund, cancellations with less notice will be charged at the full rate. All bookings must be made by using the Entry Form, which can be downloaded from: <a href="http://www.longlane.jejik.co.uk/">http://www.longlane.jejik.co.uk/</a> along with payment. We are unable to accept entries via Facebook.
- 6 All Competition classes will be run under British Dressage Rules. The Judge's/stewards decision is final. Correctly fitting hats conforming to PAS0015 or BSEN1384 and carry the BIS kite mark must be worn at all times when riding
- 7 Dress will be usual BD Dressage competition attire. For first time competitors, we will have available some Black Jackets for hire you may therefore wear casual smart clothes underneath £10 refundable deposit, is required, we will be limited in the number we can keep, so this will be on a first come first served basis.
- 8 If the numbers allow, classes for March to September will be split into Junior and Senior, for the Championship Awards Evening these will be combined.
- 9 Long Lane is not responsible for any accidents, damage to/thefts from vehicles, whilst using the premises. Competitors are expected to have their own Insurance.
- 10 The organisers have the right to cancel or amend any class, should the need to do so. Classes will be non-refundable, unless there is a written request, by email (<a href="mailto:longlane.equestrian@hotmail.com">longlane.equestrian@hotmail.com</a>), this will then be considered by the organisers.
